



## COMPASSIONATE EXPERTS

Catalpa Health providers specialize in pediatric mental health. Based on your child's needs, your care team may include one or more of these specialists:

A **mental health therapist** evaluates and treats mental health challenges through individual, family or group settings. The therapist will conduct an evaluation to help determine your child's needs and develop a treatment plan with input from parents/guardians. The therapist may also refer your child to a psychiatrist or psychologist.

A **psychiatrist** is a licensed physician who evaluates mental health challenges and treats them with medication when the symptoms are deemed serious enough.

A **psychologist** can diagnose mental health challenges, conduct psychological testing and provide recommendations for future treatment. Often, psychologists are consulted to help clarify a diagnosis and develop a treatment plan that will best fit each child's needs. They do not prescribe medication.

**Group therapy** is often beneficial to teens and kids by providing support from others going through similar situations. Groups are led by a therapist who has experience working with teens and kids and is able to maximize the group's benefit.



## FULL RANGE OF CARE

Whatever your child struggles with, we can help. Our specialists care for a variety of emotional and mental health concerns, including:

- Attention deficit disorders (ADD/ADHD)
- Depression
- Anxiety disorders
- Bipolar disorder
- School underachievement
- Behavior problems

- Sexual, psychological or physical abuse
- Emotional trauma
- Family issues (divorce, etc.)
- Psychological / neuropsychological testing
